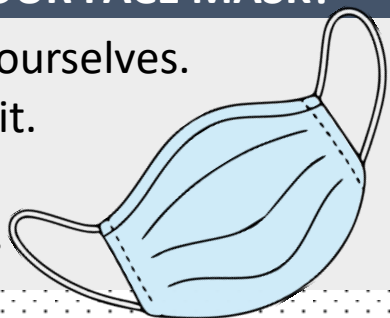

NOTE: When a word ends with *-age* with two syllables, such as *image* (*i-mage*) and *shortage* (*shor-tage*), the *-age* is pronounced as /ɪdʒ/ (as in *ij*) and **NOT** /eɪdʒ/ (as in *eyj*).
